As a founding member of this fast-action equestrian/shooting sport, he serves on the Board of Directors of the Cowboy Mounted Shooting Association, better known as the CMSA and he is a member of the SASS Hall of Fame.

The Spangenberg name has become a familiar one in the entertainment industry too. He's been featured as an on-camera interviewee in several top television programs such as The History Channel's "Tales Of The Gun," "Modern Marvels," and most recently, their "Wild West Tech" series, starring Keith Carradine.

Currently he is also is the Firearms Editor and a regular columnist for *True West* magazine.
